



Bambach's CEO Alf Chown was pleased to attend the Rolling Stock Collaboration event hosted by Australian Industry Group on 11th May.

Victorian State Government Rail Advocate Jill Walsh opened proceedings and outlined the immense opportunities open to Australian businesses in supplying to the Australian Rolling Stock Industry. With multibillion dollar contracts awarded in WA, Victoria, NSW and Queensland for new train sets to be built in Australia there has never been as much activity in this sector as is occurring now. In total some \$15 billion of contracts is expected to be awarded for new train and tram sets over the coming ten years with half that amount already awarded and production for train sets already underway.

Bambach believe we are well placed to become a major supplier of cable into the Rolling Stock Industry thanks to our RailX range of cables which are due to be released into the market later this year.

The range includes single core power cables for use on Locomotives and Carriages and will be manufactured in their Rosedale, Victoria facility.

Another cable in Development at Bambach at the moment is our new Silicone range which is expected to launch shortly after the RailX cables. This range will be suitable for many industries but also for Passenger Trains and Tram sets and was initially developed to keep up with the growing demand that Bambach were constantly in discussions about to boost local content and Australian Made alternatives.
